

Record

Think of DAN as your dedicated record keeping nurse. Speak as you go and DAN will pick it up and make sure it is in the record.

Tell the patient what you are checking and finding

"We'll do your oral cancer screening next. We'll check your lips, your cheeks, your tongue ... and everything is looking good."

Say which tooth you're talking about


"this tooth here, your UR6, ..."

Say out teeth and scores, the way you'd them to appear:

"UR8 good, UR7 good, UR6 large MOD composite, palatal hairline fracture. Ideally needs onlay."

"BPE one, one, one, slash, two, two"

Write



The quickest way to start is with "Magic my notes", generating a succinct clinical summary of the appointment.



Select a "Write my notes" template to generate a written record just the way you like it.



"Write a letter" templates generates correspondence for a patient, another dentist, or whoever you need in seconds.



"Something else" provides you with the freedom to ask anything of your appointment.

Review the generated notes


It remains the responsibility of the clinician to check and verify that information is correct.

Refine

As you become familiar with DAN, you will be able to refine how to get the most out of DAN.

Refine templates

All templates in DAN are fully editable providing you with full control of how your records are structured and what information is included.

Trim and edit the example templates to include only the items relevant to your practice.

Add aspects that you cover that are not included in an example template.

Use "Precise mode" for exact control over the structure, content and expression of your notes including set texts and defined options.

Refine what you say

DAN generates your notes from the information in the transcript.

If information is not in the transcript, DAN will not be able to include it.

If DAN didn't populate a template with information you did cover, could you be more explicit next time?
